Director Gauri Chadha's Gawah, a documentary on Indian partition and terror attacks, will be screened at the ongoing women's international film festival in Mumbai.

The story captures the life and struggle of the people who have suffered the aftermath extending from the 1947 India-Pakistan partition to the 26/11 Mumbai terror attacks and the 2011 Mumbai serial blasts.

The documentary has won many awards and has travelled to festivals such as Cannes, Beverly Hills Film Festival, Arizona International Film Festival, Dada Saheb Phalke Film Festival in India and the London International Film Festival. It will release in India this year.
